## Defence of Welfare and people that depend on it

(based on the experiences of "Larkin Warren")

## **Definition of Welfare:**

- -Provision of a minimal level of **wellbeing** and **social support** for all citizens, sometimes referred to as *public aid*.
  - In most developed countries welfare is largely provided by the government, in addition to charities, informal social groups, religious groups and inter-government organizations.

## Mr. Romney's opinion:

- -"And so my job is not to worry about those people"
- -"I'll never convince them, they should take personal responsibility and care for their lives"
- → Wanted to become president without worrying about <u>47%</u> of the country! (nonsense number: talks about people not paying federal income tax)

## Larkin Warren:

- Single Parent mother, working two jobs
- → not even enough money to continue studying
- With the help of her mother, she got readmitted to the University of New Hampshire. (Full-time undergraduate)
- By the end of the first semester her work-study earnings weren't enough!
- → A friend suggested A.F.D.C. / food stamps (Aid to Families with Dependent Children)
- !! Strict controls, what her money was spent for!!
- Graduated with the help of social support, two weeks later she was off welfare and became an English teacher.
- <u>Today:</u> Satisfied with her life, supports herself + child
  - Thankful that she had the privilege of getting welfare
