### Requirements:

- You are to give a presentation on the subject you drew.
- If you fail to do so without a serious reason on the given date you will receive the mark 00 ("printer problems" is no excuse!)
- If you cannot give the presentation on the date given, say so three days in advance, otherwise you will be given the mark 00
- You have to distribute a handout<sup>1</sup> among the audience, which
  you hand in to the teacher at least TWO DAYS BEFORE the
  presentation (it will be copied for you). Failure to do so will
  lower your mark. (You can also send it to <a href="mailto:schul.post@yahoo.de">schul.post@yahoo.de</a>)
- The time to hold your presentation: 7-15 min
- If you need extra material or gadgets, say so at least the day before
- Remember that your presentation can be part of the next interrogation/pop quiz

- Make your intro interesting using e.g. a picture, sound, song, film extract, quotation, thing, question to the audience, acting, etc
- Structure your presentation well and let the audience "see" this structure
