

- 1-8 In Germany a conference on Islam has suggested to introduce teaching Islam at schools.
- 9-14 ---
- 15-25 It is to be more than just telling youngsters something about Islam, and will therefore require training special teachers in (62-69) German, Islamic studies and educational science for about five years, who will then teach Islam in perfect German.
- 26-31 ---
- 32-37 One advantage of this will be that the next generation of Muslims in Germany/Turkish children will be able to speak German much better than their parents or grandparents ...
- 38 -42 (which Muslims generally welcome).
- 43-58 They wish that the lessons, as well as Mosques, should be open not only to Turkish children, but the reject the idea of Muslim and Christian children getting the same lessons in religious education together.
- 70-79 Critics fear that the lessons in Islam could be too indoctrinating/religious lectures that do not allow critical questions (– a fear not shared by Muslims who think it normal to ask critical questions about their own religion)
